Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) will be received electronically until June 4, 2026 at 5:00 PM local time in Joliet, IL.

The Work includes the following:

Tree removal, consisting of cutting, removal, and disposal, and related services, in advance of construction of water transmission mains. The work will be in the general vicinity of the area in which the water transmission mains for the Alternative Water Source Program will be installed, between Chicago and Joliet, Illinois. In order to meet environmental permit conditions, services will need to be performed during the months of November 2026 through March 2027.

Responders are advised that any contract(s) awarded under this RFQ are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The procurement must comply with the requirements of the Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (WIFIA). The Contract shall be subject to the provisions of the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/1 et seq.) and the Davis-Bacon Wage Act (40 USC 276a through 276a-5) as defined by the United States Department of Labor, to the extent required by law. Attention of responders is particularly called to the requirements regarding conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to paid under the Contract.
